POSTING OF SECRETARY, NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR HUMAN RIGHTS

National Commission for Human Rights (NCHR) is an autonomous body established under the NCHR Act, 2012 (Annex-I). Under the Section 3(2)(e) of the NCHR Act, the Secretary of the Commission is to be appointed by the Commission.

- The Chairperson NCHR has informed that the post of Secretary (BS-21) in the NCHR is vacant since 2019. She has requested the Establishment Division for placing the services of Malik Kamran Azam Khan, a BS-20 officer of Federal Board of Revenue, as Secretary, NCHR, in his own pay scale under Section-10 of Civil Servants Act, 1973 (Annex-II).
 - 3. The Recruitment Rules of NCHR have not yet been approved by the Federal Government. Section 29(4) of the NCHR Act, 2012 provides that the Federal Government may appoint any officer or employee of the federation to the Commission on deputation basis.
 - 4. The Federal Board of Revenue has issued NOC for posting of Malik Kamran Azam Khan, a BS-20 Officer of Pakistan Customs Service, as Secretary, NCHR (Annex-III). The service profile of the officer is at (Annex-IV).
 - 5. The Establishment Division in their views have conveyed that as per Rule 18(1) of the Rules of Business, 1973, the Federal Minister for Human Rights may place the summary before the Cabinet for consideration (Annex-V).
 - 6. Approval of the Federal Cabinet is solicited to the posting of Malik Kamran Azam Khan, a BS-20 officer of Federal Board of Revenue, as Secretary, National Commission for Human Rights, in his own pay scale, under Section 10 of Civil Servants Act, 1973.
 - 7. The Federal Minister for Human Rights has seen and approved the submission of this Summary.
