 - i. Ministry of Planning, Development & Special Initiatives is implementing Prime Minister Delivery Unit (PMDU) Task No. T10427C "Initiative # 134 - Disability Friendly PC-I checklist to give greater salience to disability through ensuring that PC-I caters to needs of disabled population and is inclusive for all. The purpose of the initiative is to make PC-Is disabled friendly and inclusive by promoting inclusion in project and program proposals by taking necessary institutional measures towards allowing ease of access through creating barrier free physical and social environment for Persons with Disabilities.
 - ii. The CDWP meeting held on 16th September 2020 has approved draft disability friendly PC-I checklist with direction to hold further consultation (copy of minutes enclosed).
- iii. Towards the task completion, Ministry of Planning, Development & Special Initiatives had organized a consultative workshop with the support of World Health Organization (WHO) at Peshawar on Disability Friendly Checklist developed by Technical Advisory Group on Disability at federal level on 23rd September 2021 and is required to arrange further workshop at Karachi, Quetta, Lahore, Muzaffarabad, and Gilgit-Baltistan.
- iv. It is apprised that the next consultative workshop with support of WHO is tentatively planned in January 2023. In this regard, your technical inputs and cooperation in consultative process towards the task completion will be appreciated, please.
