The National Commission for Human Rights is an independent statutory body created to look into matters pertaining to all forms of violations of human rights within the territorial jurisdiction of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan by virtue of the National Commission for Human Rights Act of 2012.

- 2. I am directed to enclose herewith a self-explanatory application submitted by a 93 years old and ailing lady for appropriate order to meet the ends of justice. Bare reading of application along with annexure revealed that its matter of inheritance which had been decided by the honorable courts after long litigation. Up till now approximately 50 years have passed without any relief to the applicant. Currently, the applicant has submitted application before the honorable Ombudsmen, Punjab for redressal of grievance.
- 3. In view of the above, the Honorable Federal Ombudsmen is requested to please take up this matter and may pass necessary direction in the larger interest of justice,
