## SUBJECT: MEETING OF THE SENATE STANDING COMMITTEE FOR HUMAN RIGHTS HELD ON 03.04.2023

During the meeting of the Senate Standing Committee for Human Rights held on 03.04.2023, the victim of F-9 Park incident informed the Committee that due to the incident which occurred with her on 02.02.2023, she is facing severe mental trauma as well as financial setbacks. She further informed the Committee that at the time of the incident she was serving as a Senior Sales Advisor at Propertiesbag.com (private business) which deals with real estate from where she was terminated because of the repeated visits of police officials in connection with the inquiry as well as the media personnel. She was also forced to evacuate her hostel because of Police visits. She further informed the Committee that she has been getting calls from unknown numbers and she feels unsafe and threatened.

- 3. On her statement, the Committee advised the National Commission for Human Rights to look into the matter and resolve her personal issues to such extent as possible.
- 4. On the directions of the Committee, the Commission contacted the victim and enquired about her issues. She told that she has found accommodation and is currently residing in another hostel in Sector G-9, Islamabad (previous hostel has been closed) and is unemployed as no one is willing to give her a job due to this case. She further added that she does not want to join her previous office as it is now known by many people including media.
- 6. As regards to the telephonic calls, she has been advised to contact the Commission in case of such calls and to share numbers of previous calls, which NCHR will report to the concerned law enforcement agencies or cyber-crime wing of FIA.
