Subject: **NOTICE FOR ATTENDANCE OF SP POTOHAR IN NCHR HEARING**


Dear Sir,

With reference to NCHR letter No.2 (765)/22Complaint (NCHR) on the subject "Report of Kidnapping, Forced Conversion and Marriage of 12 years Old Christian Girl from Rawalpindi Vs City Police Officer, Rawalpindi" dated 24<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 addressed to City Police Officer, intimating to appear before the Commission in the hearing proceedings, fixed for 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2022 through the nominated SP/Potohar Division Rawalpindi. **The same was not complied by the concerned officer.**

2. The National Commission for Human Rights is a statutory body with powers of a civil court under the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (Act V of 1908), 'to inquire into complaints of violations of human rights and may call for information or report from the Federal Government or a Provincial Government or any other authority as need be, within such time as may be specified by it'. The above mentioned case is of a sensitive nature as this involves a minor Christian girl, resident of Rawalpindi.

3. You are kindly requested to direct SP/Potohar Division, Rawalpindi to appear before the NCHR next date of hearing scheduled for 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2022 at 2:00 PM at NCHR Head Office, Islamabad.
