

The National Commission for Human Rights (NCHR) was established under NCHR Act, 2012 for the purpose of promotion and protection of human rights as enshrined in the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan and various international human rights instruments to which Pakistan is a state party. Furthermore, the Commission has been entrusted with the mandate to review the safeguards provided by or under the constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan or any other law for the time being in force, for the protection of human rights and to recommend adoption of new legislation, amendment of existing laws and the adoption or amendment of administrative measures for their effective implementation.
